Long before Alexander the Great's conquests, Greeks had discovered great opportunities for conquest in the East •In 401 BCE, a Persian prince, Cyrus, had raised a force of 10,000 Greek mercenaries to fight his older brother for the throne •Although the Greeks defeated a huge Persian army, the prince was killed in the first major battle
