13 What is the fluid power? Fluid power is the energy transmitted and controlled by means of a pressurized fluid, either liquid or gas The term fluid power applies to both hydraulics and pneumatics Hydraulics (oil or water) use liquids under pressure while pneumatics use compressed air or other neutral gases

Usually, electrical power is used to drive impellers in stirred tanks For a given stirred speed, the power required depends on the resistance offered by the fluid to rotation of the impeller Average power consumption per unit volume for industrial bioreactors ranges from 10 kW m<sup>-3</sup> for small vessels to 1~2 kW m<sup>-3</sup> for large vessels
