tories However, no language has ever been spoken by a mother-tongue majority in more than a few countries (Spanish leads, in this respect, in some twenty countries, chiefly in Latin America), so mother-tongue use by itself cannot give a language global status To achieve such a status, a language has to be taken up by other countries around the world

contrary, the emergence of economic power may be the consequence of power existing on other grounds Man does not strive for power only in order to enrich himself economically Power, including economic power, may be valued "for its own sake" Very frequently the striving for power is also conditioned by the social "honor" it entails
