Feb 02, 2017 · • Established markup rates that were slightly higher than typical rates • Did not specify the allowed markup rates and paid the rates the contractor submitted • Paid for bonding costs and B&O taxes though they are typically covered by markups or were prohibited by contract • The higher markups totaled \$101,000 out of the \$32 million
