Nigerian Dwarf Dairy Goats are the only miniature breed of dairy goats recognized by the American Dairy Goat Association They are 18-22" tall at the shoulder when they reach adult size Pregnancy length for all breeds of goats is 145-155 days Diagnoses of pregnancy in the larger breeds of goats can be performed by ultrasound

FEEDING AND MANAGEMENT OF MILKING GOATS

In practical dairy feeding a 16% ration is most widely used for lactating goats and hay less than 12% protein is generally not recommended As with lactating cattle, goats in early lactation can't consume enough energy and must use body fat reserves for milk production It will take from 6-10 weeks for a goat to achieve maximum dry matter intake
