10 Tips for Handling a Schizophrenia Crisis • Remember that you cannot reason with acute psychosis • Remember that the person may be terrified by his/her own feelings of loss of control • Do not express irritation or anger • Do not shout • Do not use sarcasm as a weapon • Decrease distractions (turn off the TV, radio, fluorescent lights that hum, etc)
