Two-Word Strategy

Revisit, Reflect, Retell Heinemann, 1998 Hoyt, Linda "Many Ways of Knowing: Using Drama, Oral Interactions and the Visual Arts to Enhance Reading • understanding and use of strategies employed by effective readers • the nature of the text itself (difficulty and interest) • the type or genre of text (eg, fiction, nonfiction, poetry)

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strategies: predicting, questioning, clarifying, and summarizing • Scaffold the four strategies by modeling, guiding, and applying the strategies while reading • Guide students to become metacognitive and reflective in their strategy use • Help students monitor their reading comprehension using the four strategies
